



## How to find us

**Kiss Wood Cabins** at Nettlebeds farm in the village of Wincle, SK11 0QG, between Congleton and Buxton, off the A54. **Please do not go down to Broomhills Farm**

### BY MOTORWAY

#### From the South

Take M6 northbound from Birmingham. Leave at J 17, taking the A534 eastbound to Congleton.

#### From the North

Take M6 southbound. Leave at J 18, taking the A54 eastbound to Holmes Chapel. Stay on the A54 all the way to Congleton. **From Congleton** - take the A54 out of Congleton, following signs for Buxton. Continue on the A54, crossing the A523 at a major crossroads (traffic lights) and carry on for a further 3 miles. The road climbs steeply as you leave the Cheshire Plain, and at the top of the hill there is a crossroads by a motel. Here need to take a right turn, signposted to Wincle, into Barlow Hill. Follow this road down the hill for 1/4 mile, until you come to a right turn by millennium stone. Take this right turn, and follow the road for about 1 mile go over one cattle grid and before the second cattle grid you will see our sign, turn right into and down are farm track. Once approaching the farm take the left turning and follow the left track, park in the designated parking area.

**From the East From Buxton** – take the A54 out of Buxton, following signs for Congleton and Macclesfield. About a mile out of Buxton, the A54 forks to the left - make sure you stay on the A54, following signs for Congleton. Carry on for around 5 miles. Ignore the sign for Wincle where there is a sharp right-hand bend and then a sharp left-hand bend at the bridge at the bottom of the valley Instead climb the steep hill for a further 1 1/2 miles, where it flattens out, at the crossroads take the turning left following the sign to Wincle, Follow this road down the hill for 1/4 mile, until you come to a right turn by millennium stone. Take this right turn, and follow the road for about 1 mile go over one cattle grid and before the second cattle grid you will see our sign,

turn right into and down are farm track. Once approaching the farm take the left turning and follow the left track, park in the designated parking area.

**From Leek** – take the A523 out of Leek, following signs for Macclesfield. Carry on until you will reach the village of Bosley, where you need to take a right turn onto the A54, at a large crossroads with traffic lights. Follow this road for 3 miles. The road climbs steeply as you leave the Cheshire Plain, and at the top of the hill there is a crossroads by a motel. Here you need to take a right turn, signposted to Wincle, into Barlow Hill. Follow this road down the hill for 1/4 mile, until you come to a right turn by millennium stone. Take this right turn, and follow the road for about 1 mile before the second cattle grid you will see our sign, turn right into and down are farm track. Once approaching the farm take the left turning and follow the left track, park in the designated parking area.

#### From Macclesfield

From the A523 turn onto Bryons Lane heading to Sutton, follow this road for 6 miles continuing along Hollins lane, once you reach the giveaway junction joining the A54 keep left up the hill, at the crossroads where the four ways motel is turn right signposted Wincle on Barlow Hill. Follow this road down the hill for 1/4 mile, until you come to a right turn by millennium stone. Take this right turn, and follow the road for about 1 mile before the second cattle grid you will see our sign, turn right into and down are farm track. Once approaching the farm take the left turning and follow the left track, park in the designated parking area.

#### FROM THE AIRPORTS

We are just under 18 miles from **Manchester Airport**. The easiest way to get to Kiss Wood Cabins from the airport is to get a direct train to Macclesfield and to get a taxi from the station. We are about 45 miles from **Liverpool John Lennon Airport**, and about 50 miles from **East Midlands** airport.

#### BY TRAIN

Macclesfield Railway Station is 8 miles away. You can catch direct trains here to London, Manchester and Manchester Airport, Birmingham and to major stations to the north and east. A taxi from the station to Kiss Wood Cabins will cost around £18 – it will cost extra after 11.30pm and on public holidays.
